Martin Methodist College's Transfer Policy states:

Students who hold an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree from a Tennessee Community College or from a senior institution within the state, that is designed for transfer to a baccalaureate program at a senior institution will be admitted with junior standing. Students holding an applied degree (e.g., A.A.S.) must have their transcripts evaluated on an individual basis, and recognized courses may be credited toward graduation. Students with A.A. or A.S. degree from other states must also have their transcripts evaluated, but generally will also be admitted with junior standing. Certain

academic programs may have special core requirements that the transfer student may be required to complete. During the first semester of attendance, transfer students will be notified by letter of the courses accepted for transfer. Martin Methodist College does not transfer grades of “D” or lower except when a student has graduated with an Associate (A.A. or A.S) or Bachelor’s degree with an overall GPA of 2.0 or above.

If a degree is considered “non-transferrable” courses will be evaluated on an individual basis, and students will not automatically receive junior status.
