

Student Achievement Outcomes



Martin Methodist College is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's student achievement data.

Graduation Rate (2011 Cohort: 34%; Goal: 45%)

This rate reflects the graduation/completion status of students who enrolled during the 2011-12 school year and for whom 150% of the normal time-to-completion has elapsed.

During the fall semester of 2011, 263 first-time, full-time, certificate or degree-seeking Undergraduate students entered Martin Methodist College. After 6 years (as of August 31, 2017) 34% of these students had graduated from our institution or completed their programs.

First-Time, Full-Time, Fall-to-Fall Retention Rate (2017 Cohort: 52%; Goal: 60%)

This rate reflects the enrollment status of first-time, full-time, degree-seeking undergraduate students who enrolled during the Fall 2017 semester.

During the fall semester of 2017, 244 first-time, full-time, certificate or degree-seeking Undergraduate students entered Martin Methodist College. As of the Census Day (September 12, 2018), 52% of these students were enrolled for Fall 2018.

Nursing NCLEX Pass Rate (2018 Cohort: 87%; Goal: 85%)

The College's Nursing program is accredited by the Tennessee Board of Nursing. One requirement for such accreditation is that the program's graduates achieve a first-time NCLEX-RN pass rate of at least 85%. This target, along with the pass rate for Martin Methodist College, is published on the Board of Nursing's website. In 2018 the pass rate for first time NCLEX-RN Martin Methodist graduates was 87%.

State Licensure Passing Rates in Education (Goal: 100%)

Passing scores on the Praxis tests, a set of content specific assessments published by the Educational Testing Service, are required for the Tennessee Department of Education Office of Educator Licensure and Preparation to issue a teaching license. The passing scores, which are determined and published annually by the Tennessee Board of Education, are required by Martin Methodist's Department of Education before a candidate is allowed to enter clinical practice. The College publishes a three-year average of aggregated passing rates for its students on the Consumer Information webpage. Martin Methodist's Department of Education uses the scores as a significant measure to ensure program quality in its annual program assessment.

The following scores are a three year average for the Division of Education's traditional and transitional programs:
