ABILITY LEVEL GUIDE:

- ❖ **Preschool Aquatics Level 1 - 3**
 - Ages 3 – 5 that have never had lessons before and may be scared of water
- ❖ **Learn to Swim Level 1**
 - Ages 5 and up that have never had lessons before and may be scared of water
- ❖ **Learn to Swim Level 2**
 - Ages 5 and up that have had lessons before. Will learn fundamental skills
- ❖ **Learn to Swim Level 3**
 - Ages 5 and up that have had lessons before and know fundamental skills. Will be in deeper water (5 ft.)
- ❖ **Learn to Swim Level 4**
 - Students that can swim. Will learn basic stroke development
- ❖ **Learn to Swim Level 5**
 - Students that can swim. Will be introduced to and learn all kinds of strokes

- ✓ Please pack light and bring swimming necessities only (swimming suit, towel, flip flops)
- ✓ Students cannot wear or bring any type of float (arm floats ect.)
- ✓ Parents are not allowed in the pool area during swim lessons due to indoor space. Once the class begins please enjoy our patio outside. Children under the age of 6 must have a parent available at all times.
